### 1. Field activities:

- o Prepare, conduct, and supervise field activities and financial plans.
- o Design and apply assessment tools to measure training effectiveness.
- Prepare maps for targeted areas.

## 2. Training coordination:

- Participate in evaluations and make recommendations on training material and methodology.
- Coordinate with stakeholders to facilitate project activities.
- o Attend internal and external meetings as directed by the Project Manager.
- o Commit to implementing field activities as per YPO standards.
- o Communicate and invite trainees to attend training courses according to the plan.
- o Handle logistics for training activities, including venues and equipment.

# 3. Training implementation:

- o Provide technical training using recognized techniques and tools.
- Supervise off-site training activities for participants.
- o Provide coaching and mentorship to trained trainees.
- Provide extension services to fish farmers.

## 4. Monitoring and Reporting:

- Track and report on training outcomes.
- Maintain participants' training records.

o Write daily and weekly field activity reports.



### 5. Feedback and Evaluation:

- Evaluate the performance of trainees and provide feedback to the Project Manager.
- o Provide feedback to project participants and management.
- Monitor fish farms to ensure the employment of other young people.

# 6. Questionnaire and Spot Check:

- o Develop a simple questionnaire for fish farmers and trainees for feedback.
- Conduct mini spot-check exercises after 1-2 weeks and a questionnaire at the project's end.

#### 7. Success stories and Additional tasks:

- Keep an eye on success stories within the project.
- o Carry out tasks as assigned by the supervisor (Project Manager).
